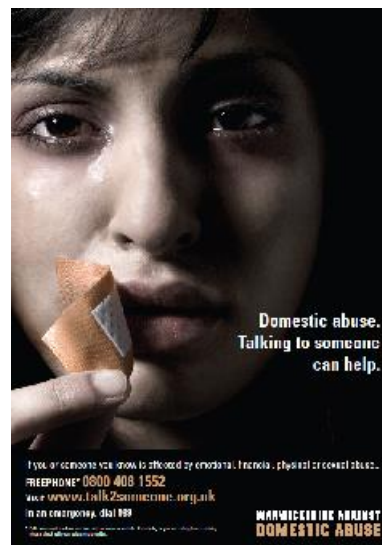

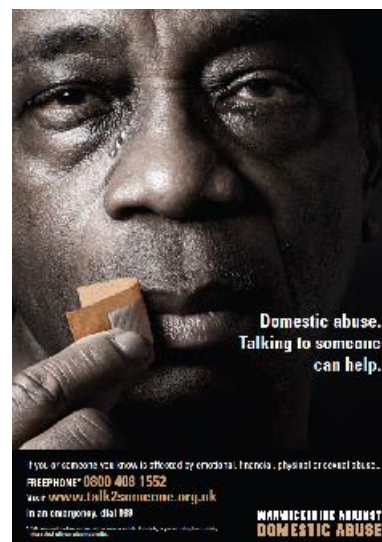

| <p>WHAT IS HONOUR BASED VIOLENCE?</p> <p>Honour based violence (HBV) is a violent crime or incident which may have been committed to protect or defend the honour of the family or community.</p> <p>It is often linked to family members or acquaintances who mistakenly believe someone has brought shame to their family or community by doing something that is not in keeping with the traditional beliefs of their culture.</p> <p>Women and girls are the most common victims of honour based violence, however it can also affect men and boys. Crimes of 'honour' do not always include violence – crimes in the name of 'honour' might include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Personal attacks of any kind, including physical and sexual violence Written or verbal threats or insults Threatening or abusive phone calls, emails and instant messages Forced marriage (FM) Being taken and held against your will including sending someone back to a country from which they originally without their consent. <p>A forced marriage is one that is carried out without the consent of both people. This is very different to an arranged marriage, which both people will have agreed to.</p> | <p>REMEMBER THE ONE CHANCE RULE</p> <p>You may only have one chance to speak to a potential victim of honour based violence and may only have one chance to save a life. If the victim is allowed to walk out of the door without support being offered, that one chance might be wasted.</p> <p>MEET THE INDIVIDUAL AT RISK</p> <p>Third party views from family, friends, and community members cannot be trusted in cases of FM & HBV and so it is critical to meet the child or adult at risk of FM or HBV individually and face-to-face.</p> <p>THE DANGER OF INVOLVING THE FAMILY & COMMUNITY</p> <p>Involving families in cases of forced marriage is dangerous. It may increase the risk of serious harm to the victim. Relatives, friends, community leaders and neighbours should not be used as interpreters or advocates – despite any reassurances from this known person.</p> <p>If you come across any situation that you feel you need more advice contact the Forced Marriage Unit: Telephone: 020 7080 0151 (Mon – Fri 09.00 – 17.00) 020 7080 1930 (out of hours) Email: fm@fmu.gov.uk Web: www.fmu.gov.uk/forcedmarriage</p> <p>If you have reasonable cause to believe FM or HBV has occurred or will occur, this must be reported to the Police. | <p>WHAT TO LOOK OUT FOR</p> <p>Individuals facing HBV may appear anxious, depressed and emotionally withdrawn with low self-esteem. They may come to the attention of professionals for a variety of reasons including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Forms of communication received between victims and friends Withdrawal from education or the workplace (including poor performance, absenteeism) Criticism of the victim for 'western' adoption of dress or make-up Restrictions in leaving the house or chaperoning outside the home Onset of depression or suicidal tendencies in an otherwise happy person. | <p>safe in... warwickshire WARWICKSHIRE AGAINST DOMESTIC ABUSE</p> |

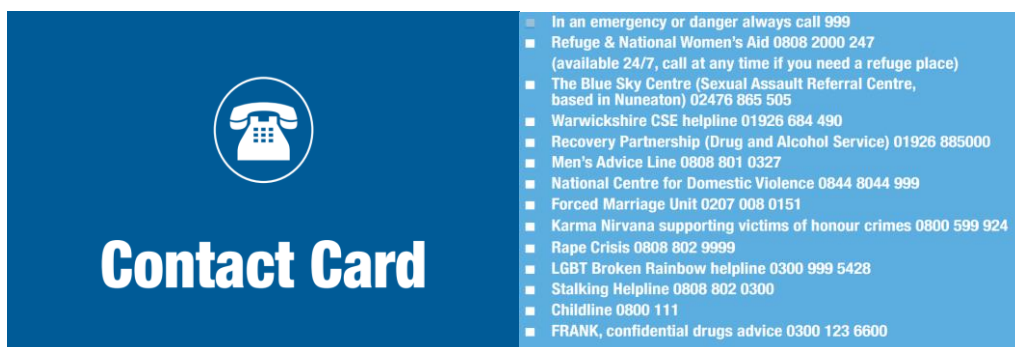
